

The following document contains New Features, Updates, Bug Fixes and other information about the latest release of CurricuNET META.

Bug Fixes

Do not copy issue on proposal modifications has been fixed

- When specifying a field on a form to not be copied when creating a modification proposal, there was an issue that caused the data to be copied even if the 'do not copy' flag was set. This has been corrected.

List summaries were not displaying in the correct order

- The summary display in lists was not displaying items in the correct order. This has been corrected.

Error deleting items in a list

- Deleting an item in a list was failing under certain conditions. Specifically when the list item referenced a checkbox that had been deleted from the system, the list item could not be deleted. This has been changed to allow configuring the system to show the deleted checkbox as an historical item. This allows proposals to display items that have been removed from the system in older proposals, but prevents selecting the deleted checkbox in new proposals. The screen shot shows how deleted items appear when they were selected prior to removing the checkbox.


- A. Communication and Analytical Thinking Requirement:** use the principles and application of language toward logical thought

Repeating lists not displaying when read-only

- When selecting a section tab on the left side of the form, if that tab contained a repeating list it would not display when the form or section was read-only. This has been corrected.

A repeating list is a fixed length checklist that allows additional data to be captured when the item is selected. Some examples of where this list might be used would be “Methods of Evaluation” or “Methods of Instruction” (See image below).

Additional bug fixes

- Other bug fixes were done that may not affect all schools. Many of these fixes affect reports for individual schools as well as other features that are configurable and may not be implemented in every Meta system.

Notifications enhancements

- Email notifications have been enhanced to allow more flexibility in the verbiage of the approval notifications.
